



Beginning October 20th, 2018, Brown County will no longer be accepting mixed Construction and Demolition (C&D) debris for recycling at our Solid Waste Transfer Station due to poor recycling markets. C&D will continue to be accepted at the Gate Rate for disposal.

Construction & Demolition Waste

RECYCLABLE:

Items Recycled (loads should contain 60% or more of the following items):

- Wood (dimensional lumber 2"x4" etc., plywood, pallets)
- Aggregates (asphalt, brick, concrete, rock)
- Cardboard
- Metal (steel and non-ferrous)
- Vinyl Siding

ACCEPTABLE as C&D Waste:

Loads commonly accepted:

- New Home Construction
- Residential Demolition
- Commercial Loads (containing large amounts of pallets and cardboard)

Loads should contain minimal amounts of:

- Shingles
- Carpet
- Plastic Wrap / Tarps
- Ceiling Tiles
- MSW (Municipal Solid Waste)
- Clothes, Mattresses, Furniture
- PVC Piping, Plastic Culverts
- Commercial Roofing and Transite Siding (asbestos concerns)

UNACCEPTABLE Waste:

Loads NOT accepted:

- Tires
- Batteries
- Chemicals
- Suspect Asbestos-Containing Materials
- Free Liquids
- Hazardous Waste
