What You Need to Know For Your Waste Disposal Appointment!

- Your business is required to perform a "Waste Determination" on your generated waste to determine how the waste should be handled. If you don't know what it is, how can it be managed properly?
- All waste accepted by the Brown County HMR facility need to be identifiable either by a legible manufacturer's label on the container, Safety Data Sheet (SDS), or your generator knowledge of the container's contents.
- Brown County HMR does have a forklift to unload palletized material and/or drums.
- The Brown County HMR accepts cash, check, or card. We can only bill those businesses that have current accounts with Brown County's Resource Recovery Department.

HMR Bulb & Batteries Requirements

<u>Required Handling: Bulbs & Batteries</u> - Per WI DNR waste code NR 673, <u>'Used Lamps'</u> AND <u>'Used Batteries'</u> are required to be stored in non-leaking, waste compatible containers that are marked with the container's fill start date and labeled with the words, "Used Lamps" or "Used Batteries". Brown County HMR requires the same criteria with items brought to the HMR facility for disposal. Additionally:

The number of lamps in each container are required to be counted and recorded.

Batteries:

The Department of Transportation has rules regarding the transporting of "Used Batteries". These rules require the terminals of rechargeable batteries (especially lithium) and any other battery over 9 volts to be taped/covered before they can be transported across U.S. roadways. This includes bringing them to the Brown County HMR.
